I am requesting funding for Roadway Resurfacing Project for Segments of Northwest 12<sup>th</sup> Street to Northwest 25<sup>th</sup> Street, from Northwest 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Northwest 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue in fiscal year 2024.

The entity to receive funding for this project is Miami-Dade County, 111 Northwest 1<sup>st</sup> Street, 14<sup>th</sup> Floor, Miami, Florida 33128. The funding would be used for milling and resurfacing to mitigate recurring pavement maintenance, which will reduce impacts to maintenance costs.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve the roadway surface and driving conditions as well as provide increased reliability and safety to this corridor.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
